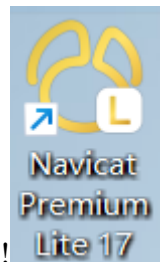


How to Use Navicat to Reset DEMS Database?、

(Applicable for forgetting the DEMS administrator password and resetting administrator permission)

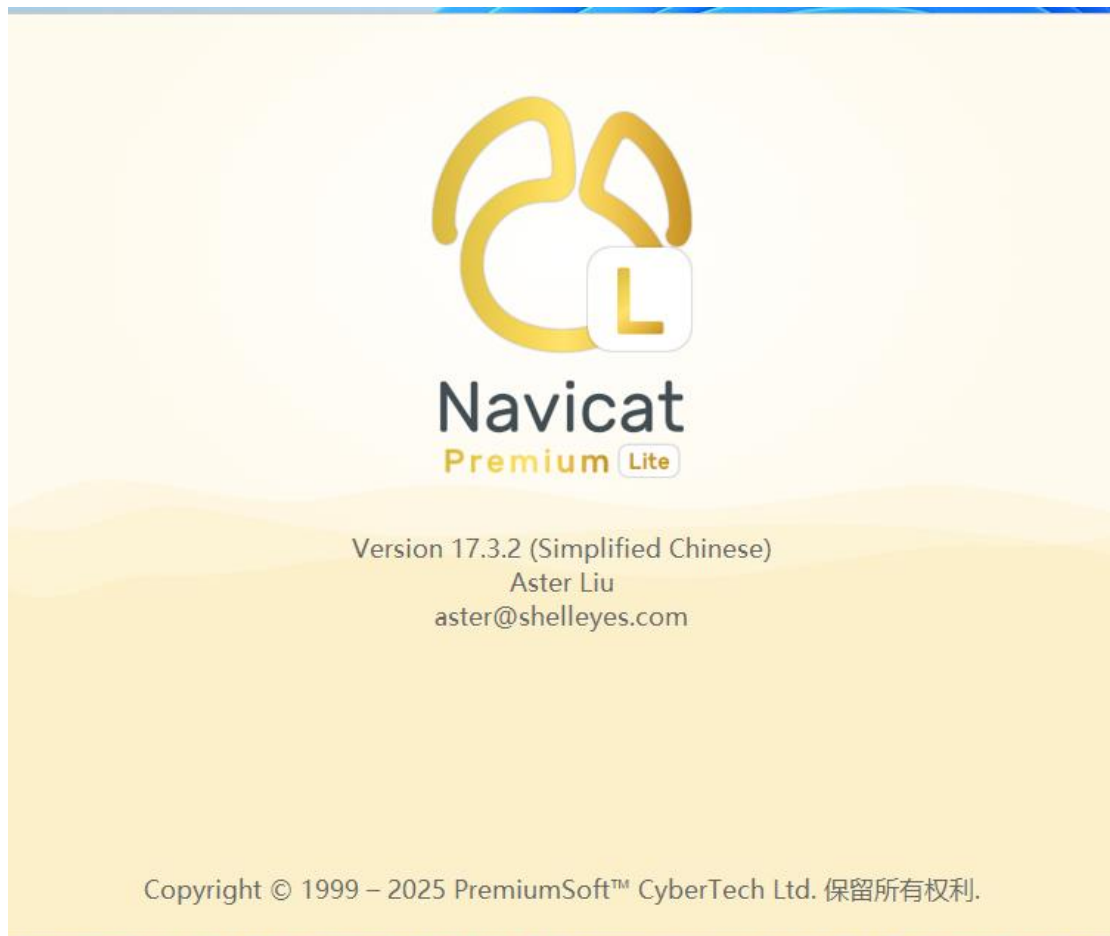
First, we need to download Navicat Premium Lite 17 (free version)

Then follow the steps below to access the DEMS database and make modifications.

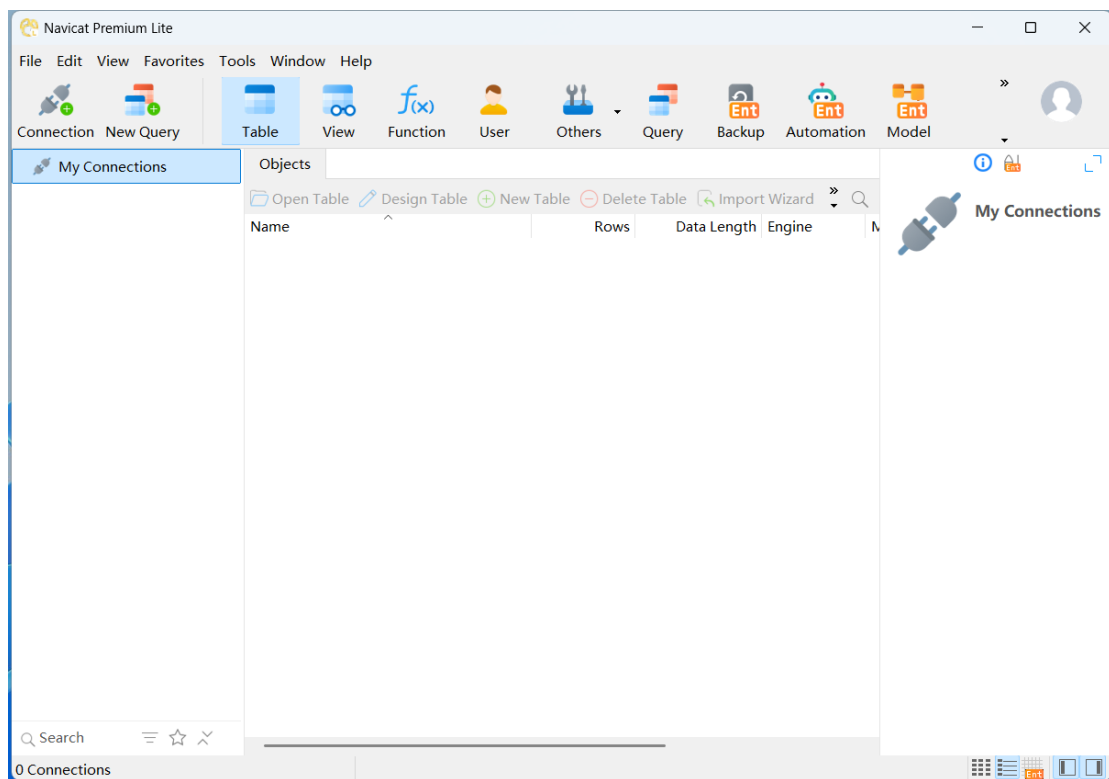


After downloading, double-click this icon!

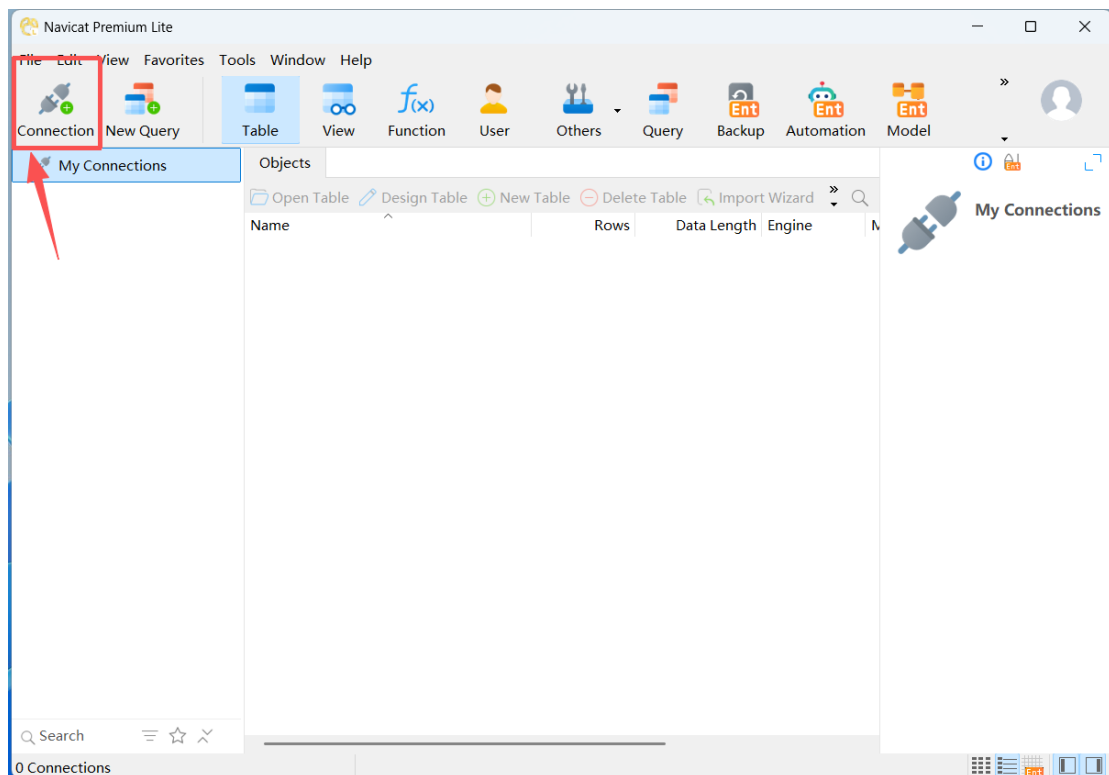
Enter the login screen,



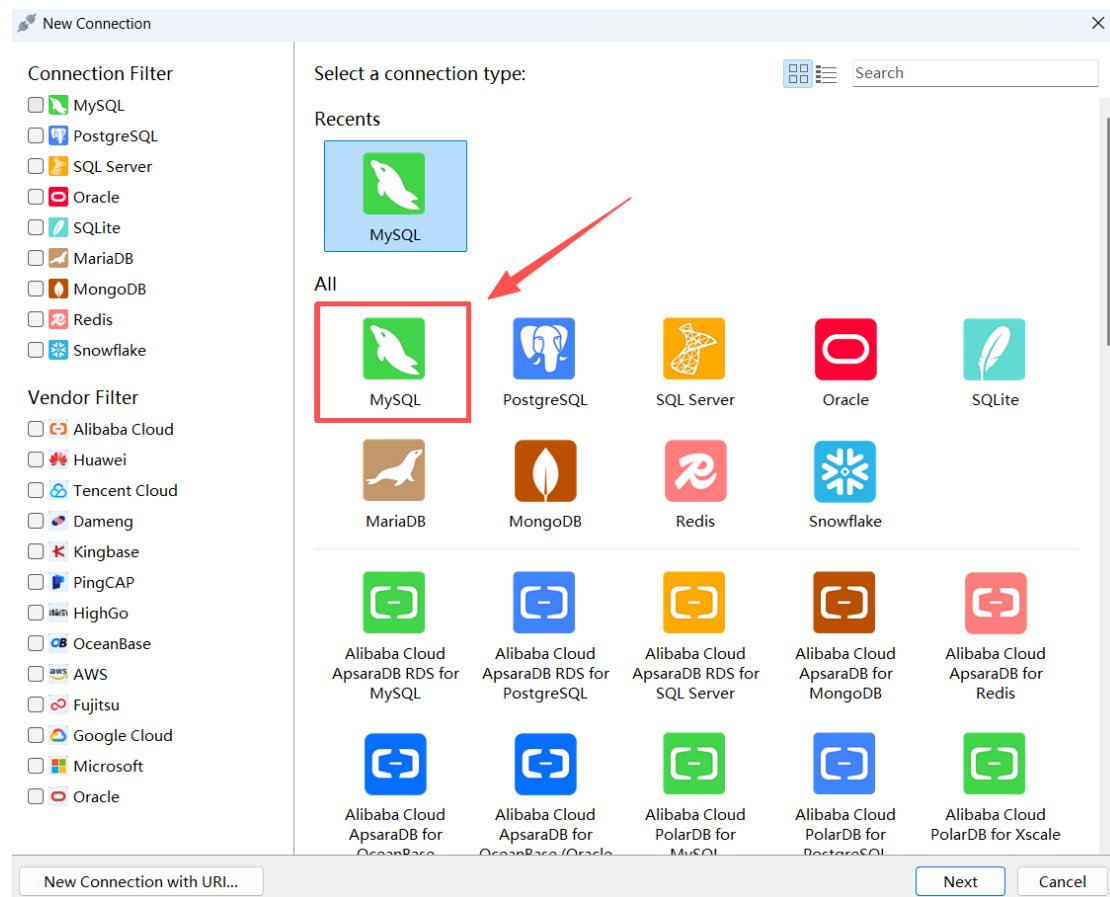
After logging in, you will enter the following interface:

Next: Double-click MySQL

Enter the connection name DEMS

Then enter the password: [**jsv5-F40D}bTi!#!**]

Then click OK

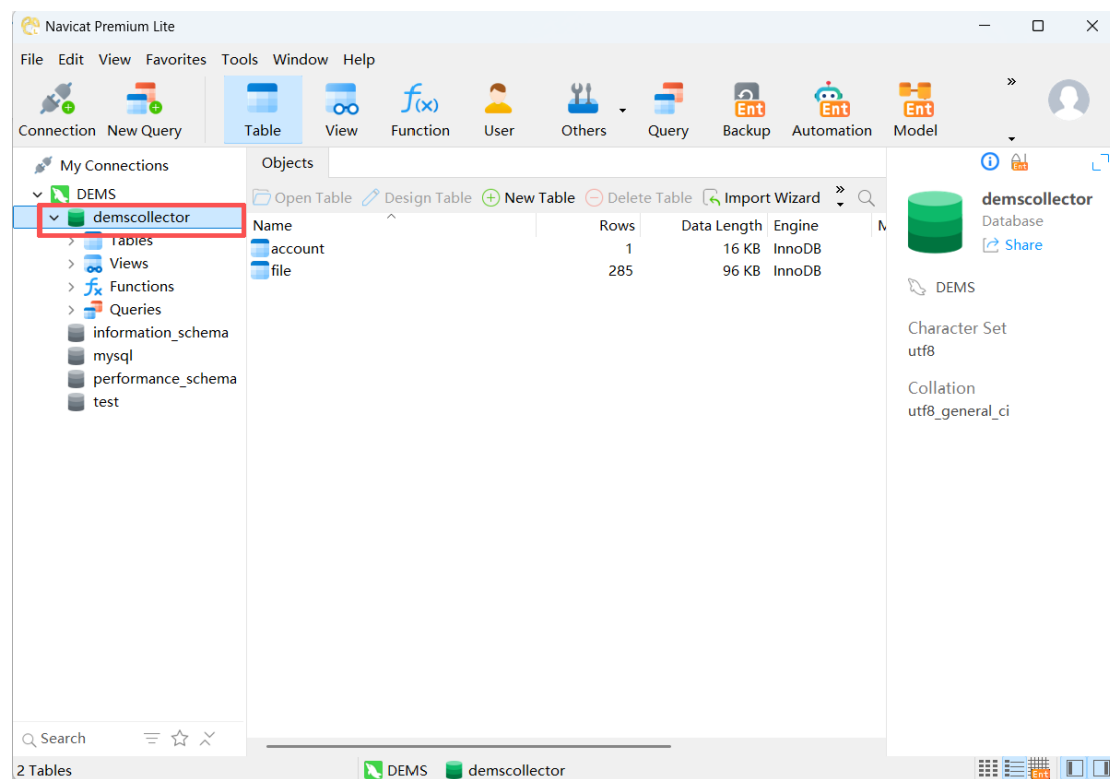
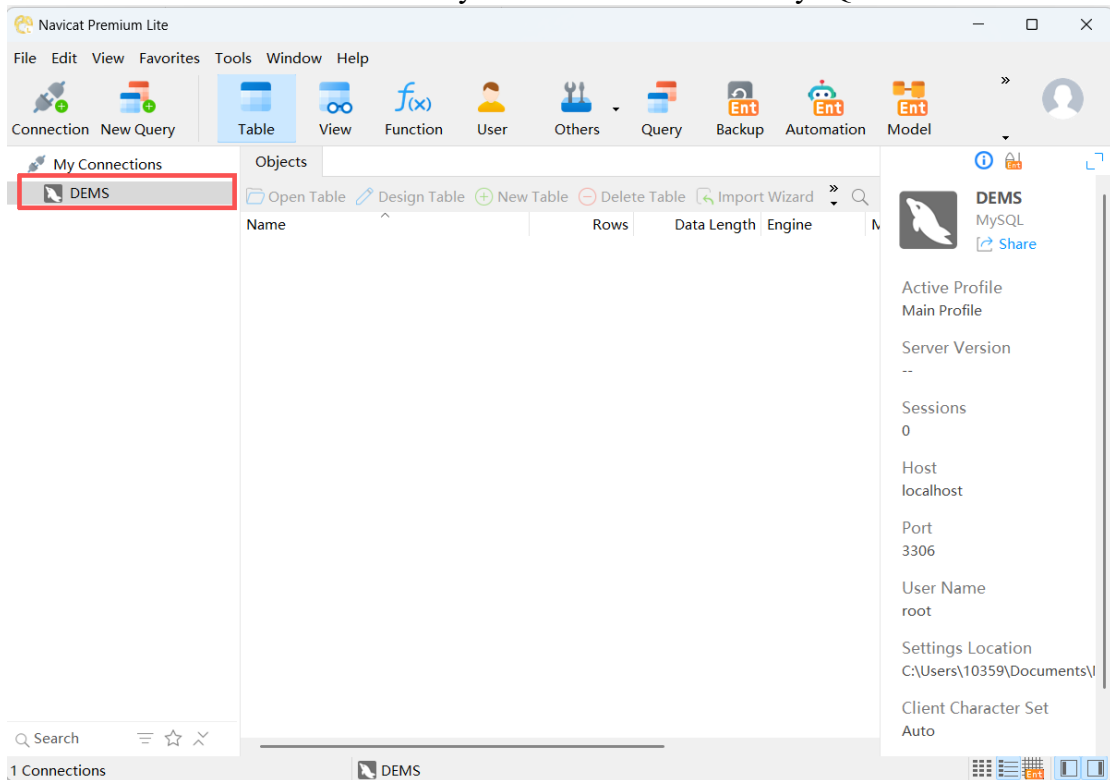

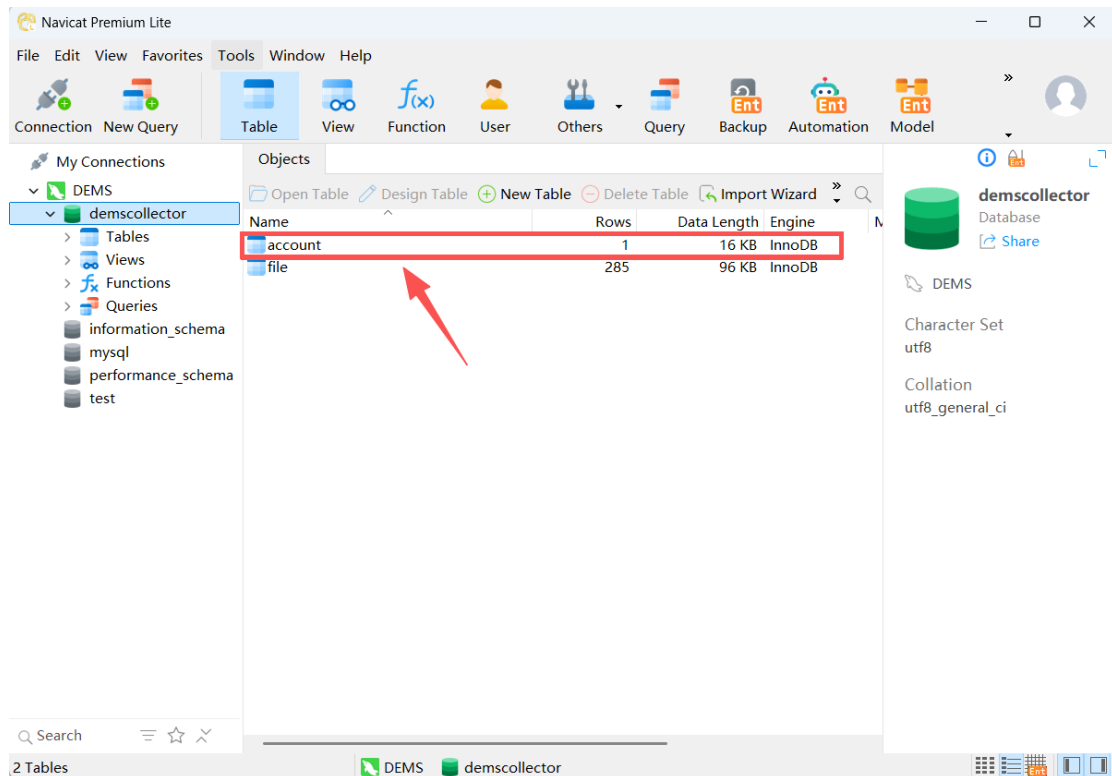

Double-click DEMS to successfully connect to the DEMS MySQL



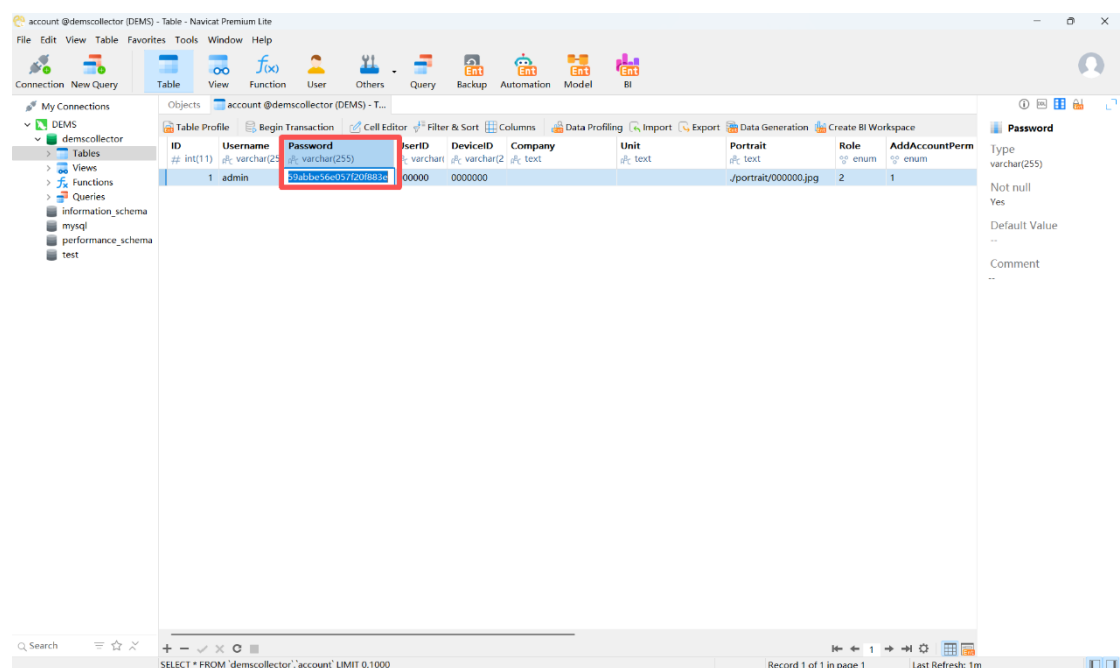
Then double-click to enter account

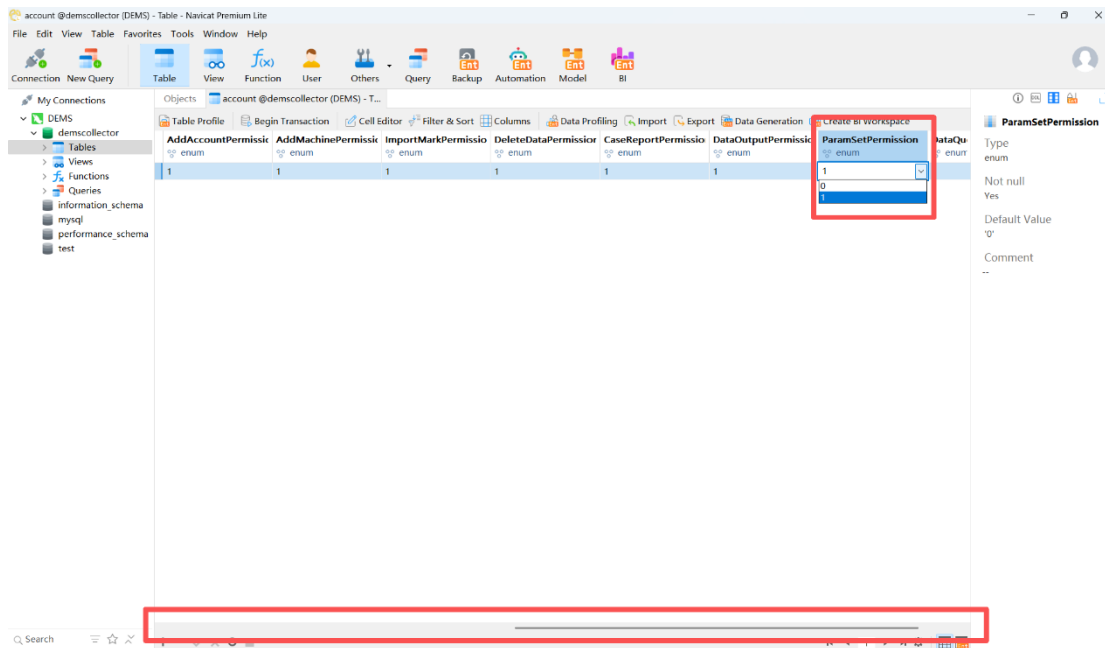


Next:

In the password field, you can reset the password

Enter **e10adc3949ba59abbe56e057f20f883e** to reset the default DEMS account password back to 123456





Drag the slider to view administrator permission options

The columns represent permissions, each column represents one permission, with 0 or 1 written

Default is 1 (enabled); 0 means disabled

To revert permissions, simply toggle the off option back to 1
